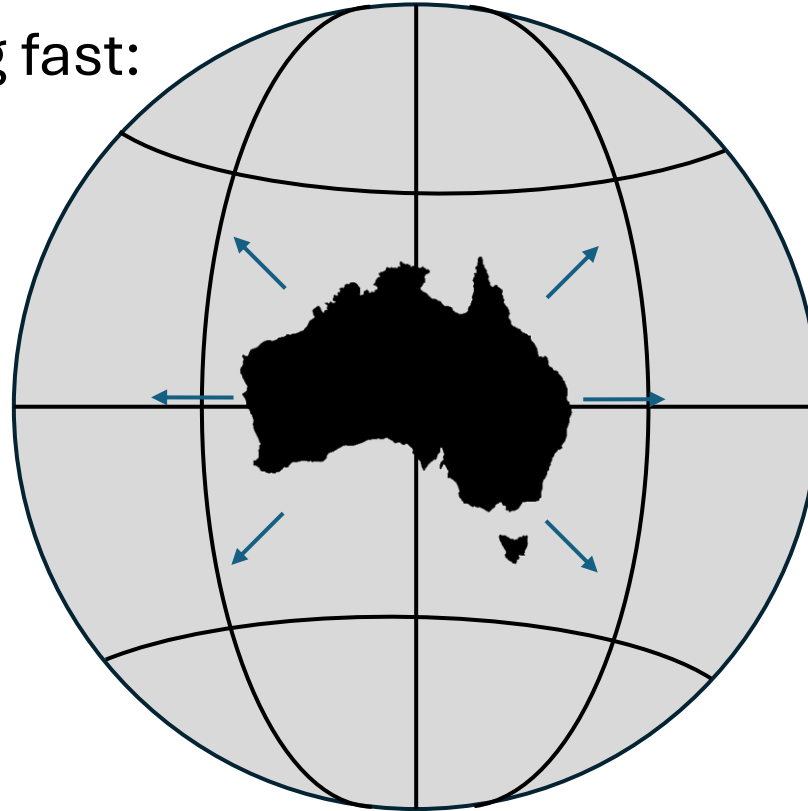

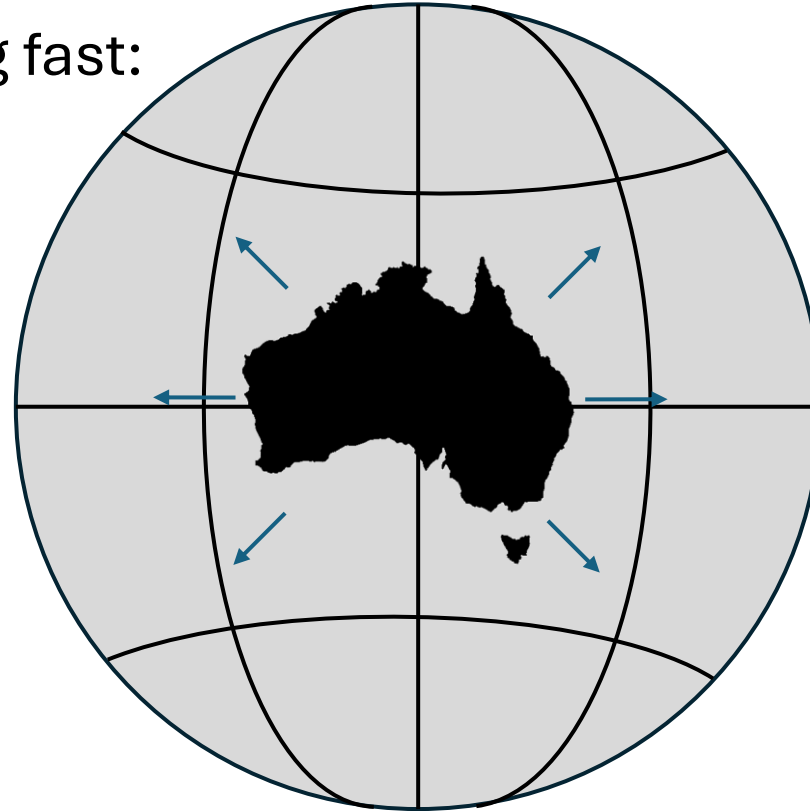
# Opportunity and cost

- **Consumer vigilance/awareness increasing<sup>3</sup>**

Supporting instrument → **United Nations Transparency Protocol (UNTP)**

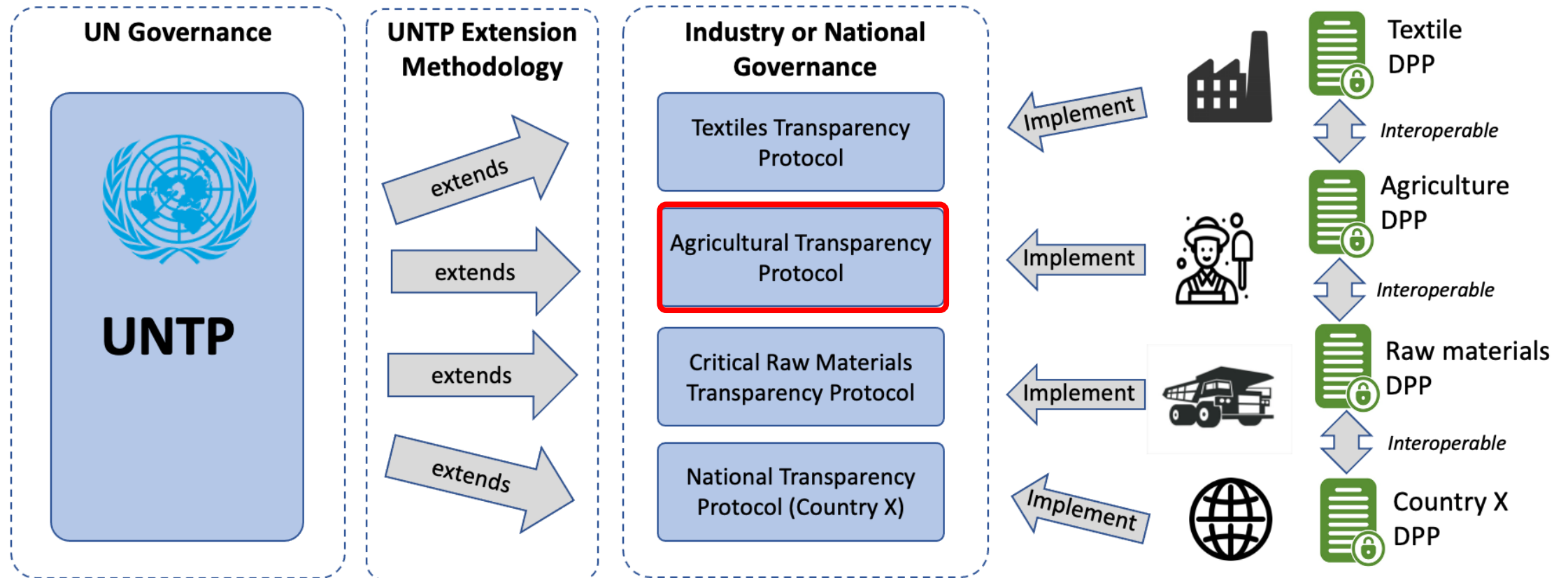
- Decentralized, open, and technology-neutral protocol
